With the help of the US Treasury, State and County programs, Community Action Partnership of Lake County was able to offer water, waste and trash utility payment assistance for the first time.

There is still much work to be done.

For the first time, many Lake County residents face food and housing insecurity. Your assistance led to more than 5,000 individuals and families being able to access our food pantry and Pop-Up Drive Through food giveaways.

Community Action Partnership of Lake County is focused on securing new partnerships while strengthening existing relationships to increase access to transitional housing. What does transitional mean in housing? The term “transitional housing” typically means housing

to facilitate the movement of individuals and families experiencing homelessness to permanent housing within a fixed amount of time.

In 2023, we want to eliminate time barriers housing insecure families face such that parent (s) and their children will have more long-term housing options.

Research shows that housing insecurity is associated with poor health, lower weight, and developmental risk among young children. Research also shows that housing insecurity is linked with Increased social system involvement and adverse outcomes for adolescents.

New. Beginning in 2021, internet services assistance programs allow low-income renters access to distance learning, telework, telemedicine and to on-line government services.
