Interim Housing/Emergency Shelter in a hotel up to 2 weeks

CAP of Lake County's Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) provides support with transitional motel costs, rental and mortgage assistance for low-to moderate income Lake County, Illinois residents. We realize the needs of families in Lake County are changing on a daily basis and we are committed to helping during this pandemic.

Applications are being accepted for assistance with Rent, Mortgage, Water/Sewer Bills and **Shelter, if needed.**

- Lake County residents must call main number at 847-249-4330
 - Press #1 for Services, then Press #3, a case manager will assist in completing a basic application over the telephone
 - Calls must be Monday-Friday between the hours of 9:00 am-4:00 pm
- Once the basic intake information is completed, the case manager will confirm documentation needed to submit in order to process the application.
- Documentation can be submitted via email, photos from a cell phone or dropped off at one of our lock-box locations.

- Each location will have a lock-box for drop offs located outside of the facility for documents if needed. This will be checked every hour.
